First, NorthWestern sought shorter, straighter, MSTI routes down Madison Valley. But these routes were killed because of “intense property owner opposition.”

Second, MSTI made a turn far to the west, *then back eastward to Dubois, ID,* because the Mill Creek Substation in Anaconda was supposedly integral to the project. All options became much longer in order to connect to Mill Creek Substation.

Third, Mill Creek connection disappeared from the MSTI project, so all the routes DEQ has considered are now much longer than necessary for no good reason. **Is this search for the best route or for the biggest loser?**
